BasicMed Protocol and Timeline

Initial Issuance of BasicMed

1. Review requirements and disqualifiers for BasicMed.
2. Go online to access BasicMed Comprehensive Medical Examination Checklist (CMEC).

 - Complete "Section 2" and print a hard copy.
3. Make an appointment at Dayton Chest Medicine (937-396-1605)
 - Bring a hard copy of your CMEC.
 - The doctor will perform a physical exam, complete Section 3 of your CMEC, and give you a copy of the completed CMEC for your records.
4. Take one of the BasicMed online courses (offered by both AOPA and Mayo Clinic) and submit it to the FAA.

 - Download and print the course completion certificate.
5. Keep a copy of your CMEC and a copy of your course completion certificate with your logbook or in electronic form.

24 Month Renewal of BasicMed

1. Review requirements and disqualifiers for BasicMed
2. Locate your most recent CMEC as you will need it for certain information.
3. Take one of the BasicMed online courses (offered by both AOPA and Mayo Clinic) and submit it to the FAA.
